

Student Exchange Agreement

The Université Libre de Bruxelles and Beihang University agree to establish a student exchange program, within the framework of their institutional Cooperation Agreement.

Article 1

Each institution will send up to 5 students (*undergraduate/graduate*) each academic year. Individual students may participate in the exchange program for *one term or semester of study or one academic year*. Every effort will be made to maintain an evenly balanced exchange from year to year. It is recognized, however, that circumstances may occasionally preclude an even exchange of students in a particular year. By mutual consent of the two institutions, imbalances may therefore be carried forward from one year to the next, as long as there is reasonable expectation that balance can be restored by adjusting the number of students in subsequent years. Every effort will then be made to restore balance to the exchange by making the appropriate enrolment adjustments.

Article 2

Students participating in the exchange program will pay tuition and all fees to their home institution. No exchange of tuition and fees funds will take place between the two institutions. Participating students will not be charged any tuition, application or program fees by the host institution.

Article 3

All expenses other than tuition and fees, such as travel expenses, room and board, books and other normal expenses of academic study, will be borne by the student. In addition, students are responsible for carrying an acceptable health insurance policy during their study abroad.

Article 4

It is understood that student housing is not guaranteed by either institution; however, the host institution will assist exchange students in locating suitable, affordable housing for the duration of the exchange period.

Article 5

Students participating in the exchange program will be selected by their respective home institutions. Students will be carefully selected with due consideration given to the possibilities of the host university and the student's adequacy of academic background, communication proficiencies and maturity. The host institution agrees to accept the exchange students so selected.

Article 6

The reporting of both credits and grades will occur. Official transcripts for each student will be sent directly to the home institution. An interpretation of grades, including a grade distribution, will be provided by the host institution. The establishment of grade equivalencies will be done by each institution for its own students.

Article 7

The financial supports for all activities mentioned in this agreement shall be sought from national and international cooperation organizations.

Article 8

The Student Exchange Agreement will effectively come into force upon signature by representatives of both parties.

The present agreement becomes effective on the date of its signature and is valid for a five-year period.

Each party may withdraw from this agreement by giving at least a six month prior written notice of its withdrawal.

Article 9

The signatories appoint Vice-Rector Serge Jaumain for ULB and Vice President Prof. TANG Xiaoqing for BUAA as coordinators of the present agreement.


